5.	Listen and talk to the coach concerned.
6.	Listen and talk to a Teacher.
7.	Report to Child Line.
8.	Write issue down and do nothing with it.
9.	Report to Social Worker at Care Agency.
10.	Talk to parent.
11.	Report to Police.
12.	Report to Duty Social Worker.
13.	Wait to talk to a professional until after the weekend.
14.	Report to Governing Body Chairperson.
